WINTER LAY-UP LASTS FROM 01-10-2020 TO 01-04-2021

- Indoor winter lay-up € 65 per m² incl. VAT**
- Pick up and drop off from the berth at Marina Port Zélande (if the key is present and there are no peculiarities)
 - Lifting out/returning to water
 - Spraying below waterline
 - Placing the boat on the cradle
 - Removing gas cylinders from the boat, placing in gas cylinder locker during lay-up (number of cylinders.....) and reinstalling on boat
 - Indoor frost-free storage (the unit is open on weekdays from 8 a.m. to 4.30 p.m., around the turn of the year we are closed for 3 weeks and the unit is not accessible)
 - Exclusive of lowering and raising masts (see next page)
- NB It is not permitted to work on boats stored indoors.
- Outdoor winter lay-up € 32 per m² including VAT**
- Pick up and drop off from the berth at Marina Port Zélande (if the key is present and there are no peculiarities)
 - Lifting out/returning to water
 - Spraying below waterline
 - Placing the boat on the cradle
 - Outdoor lay-up
- Boat stays in the water (if out of the water in spring, make a timely appointment)**
- Boat out of water in week no.2020 (target date)**

- Complete boat wash (exterior of boat) for indoor storage**
- Lower and raise the mast**
Storage of mast* outdoors € 8 / indoors € 12 per metre, length of mast.....metres.
Crane costs (own mast crane): € 46.50 per occasion + labour € 74 per hour including VAT, excluding tuning.
Crane costs when using telescopic crane due to length of mast: on the basis of subsequent calculation.
